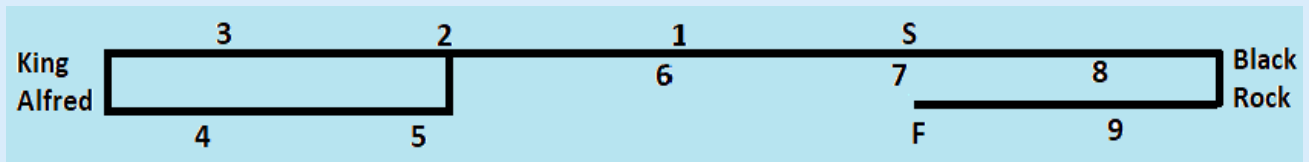


BRIGHTON 10K - ROUTE

The course has been accurately measured and certificated.

The route is a fairly straight “out and back” course, with total vertical ascent of just 6 metres over 10,000m.



The race starts and finishes on Madeira Drive, Brighton approx. 500m east of the Palace Pier. The route heads west for 3.5k on Madeira Drive and the main A259 coast road, passing the pier, the Peace Statue and Hove Lawns.

Just before the King Alfred Leisure Centre, the course turns left towards the sea and soon (90m) left again onto Hove Promenade, running eastwards along the seaside to the 5k marker at the Peace Statue.

Here the route rejoins the coast road, returning to Madeira Drive and passing

the start/finish line on the way to the final turn at Black Rock (8.5k), leaving just a 1.5k dash to the finish!
